Ascension St. John Sportsplex - Youth Basketball Official Rules - Grade 5 - 8

Pre-Game

- Teams must **check in at the score table** prior to each game and record each player's jersey number on the printed roster.
- Teams will be given time to warm up before the game begins.

Team Composition

- A minimum of **four (4)** and a maximum of **five (5)** players must be on the court at all times.
- There is **no roster limit**—teams may carry as many players as desired.
- Substitutions are permitted during **stoppages in play** and must be made within the **designated substitution area**.

Court & Ball Specifications

All games use 10-foot goals.

Ball Sizes:

- 5th-6th Grade:
 - Boys: Size 7 (29.5")
 - Girls: Size 6 (28.5")
- 7th–8th Grade:
 - Boys: Size 7 (29.5")
 - Girls: Size 6 (28.5")

Game Duration

- Games consist of **four (4) quarters**, each **6 minutes** long.
- Halftime break: 5 minutes.

- The clock will **stop on all whistles** during the final minute of each half.
- Each team receives two (2) 1-minute timeouts per half (timeouts do not carry over).

Scoring

- 2 points for baskets inside the three-point line.
- 3 points for baskets made beyond the three-point line.
- 1 point for each successful free throw.

Gameplay

- Players must dribble while advancing the ball.
- Traveling leniency is given to 3rd/4th graders only—not applicable for 5th-8th grade.
- Standard basketball rules apply to passing, shooting, free throws, and screening.

Defense

- Pressing is not allowed at this age level.
- All other standard defensive schemes are permitted.
- No physical contact beyond legal defensive play is allowed.

Fouls

- Players foul out after five (5) personal fouls.
- If a team is reduced to fewer than four (4) eligible players due to fouls, the game is **forfeited**.
- There is **no 3-second violation** in the paint at this level.

Coaching Guidelines

- Coaches must maintain a positive and respectful environment at all times.
- Do not interact with parents during the game except in case of emergency or injury.
- Coaches must remain respectful and calm, including during timeouts and stoppages.
- Foul language is strictly prohibited and may result in disciplinary action.
- A maximum of **two (2) coaches** are allowed on the bench.
 - Only one (1) coach may stand during gameplay.

Officiating

- Parents are prohibited from speaking to officials during games under any circumstances.
- Coaches may address officials in a respectful and appropriate manner.
 - o Failure to do so may result in a **technical foul** or **removal from the game**.

Sportsmanship

- All players, coaches, and spectators must demonstrate respect and good sportsmanship at all times.
- Players are expected to **shake hands with the opposing team** after each game.
- Violent or disrespectful behavior may result in a technical foul or ejection.
 - A player or coach receiving two (2) technical fouls must leave the court area for the remainder of the game.
